

Supply List

Class: Beginning / Intermediate Oil Painting

The class is limited to 10 students. The first 3 alternates will be eligible to be on a substitution list to attend class if a regular student will be absent. You will receive all of your classes or can “sell” one to an alternate.

You will need:

Oil paints

Cadmium yellow med; Shiva Yellow (purchase from teacher \$5.00);
Cadmium red (scarlet or bright); Alizarin Crimson; Pthalo or Prussian Blue;
Ultramarine Blue; Yellow Ochre; Burnt Sienna; Burnt Umber;
and a large tube of PermAlba.

Turpenoide – and 2 sealable jars at least a pint in size

Brushes

Bristle brushes – brights #12, #8, #6, #2 (or within a number up or down from that)
Sable brushes (golden talon is acceptable if necessary) flats #8, #4, #2, plus #1 or #2 round

Canvas

16” x 20” canvas or larger

Palette

Disposable Palette, white

Paper Towels

Painting knife (pallet knife bent at shank) trowel shaped and as flexible as possible

AND – a positive mental attitude!! This will be FUN!

Bring a general landscape picture (bluebonnets or summer scene) to work from. Generally the picture should have a sky, some clouds, some hills (not mountains), some nice trees and a foreground. Some water is fine. I want the first picture to be something that we are both looking at. And for this first picture I will go through general main steps in paint control and creating all the above as a group. But the results will be similar to your own choice of picture layout.

Don't worry if your equipment is not quite what I have said, we can set it right as we go. If you want to bring additional brushes, etc. That is fine.
