

## **Advanced/ Intermediate Oil Painting for Shadow Box paintings**

### **Art Supplies:**

**Local stores: Hobby Lobby, Michael's, Walmart and grocery store**

8" x 10" or 8" x 8" canvas (stretch)

A goose neck lamp with clip on base (Walmarts and Office Depot have these for around \$10.00)

1 six or eight foot extension cord to plug lamp into wall in VAC studio.

1 Shadow Box (A card board box with two sides cut off. Tape where needed for support.)

One packet of paper canvases for practicing techniques, etc

1 palette knives - small and thin (with a bend in it like a fork and a diamond shape blade).

1 package of 4 angled brushes (I'll show you in class if you are in question on this)

Large flat brush – and a variety of other size / shapes of brushes (I can show you mine at the first class.)

1 small bottle or can of turpenoid

1 sharpened pencil and a good eraser

1 piece of vine charcoal – for sketching on your canvas

1 plastic art box (fishing tackle style) to organize and carry art supplies to class.

1 Disposable Paper Palette 9x 12 sheets or larger if you want

1 package of disposable wipes (like the kind you use for baby bottoms- they are great for cleaning brushes, etc.)

Murphy's Oil - great for cleaning brushes

1 package of Thin Vine Charcoal sticks

1 can hair spray

\*\*\*You may want to use a table easel - The VAC has only a limited number of these so bring your own or get there early if you choose to use one.

### **Paint: Tube size 37 ml**

Cadmium Yellow Light

Cadmium Yellow Deep

Raw Siena

Yellow Ochre

Ultra Marine Blue

Cerulean Blue

Cadmium Orange Med

Cadmium Red Med

Cadmium Red Light

Alizarin Crimson

Sap Green

Thalo Green

Titanium White Size– 200 ml. This is the largest tube available.
