

Nancy Brown Watercolor Supply List

My palette includes the following paints. Any professional grade watercolors will be fine.

Cobalt Blue
French Ultramarine Blue
Winsor/Thalo Blue
Cerulean Blue
Alizarine Crimson
Winsor Red
Vermillion
Yellow Ochre
Cadmium Yellow Deep
Burnt Sienna
Winsor/Thalo Green
Veridian
Quinacridone Violet
Quinacridone Gold
White

You don't have to have these exact colors, but it is a good basic list. I am always trying new things and adding and subtracting colors from my palette. I like to have fun!

I use Arches Cold Press 140 lb. watercolor paper. I have a variety of brushes, both rounds and flats in different sizes. A 1" flat, a #10 or #12 round are a good start. A script liner is handy as well.

I use an 18" x 24" masonite board coated with white as my support and masking tape to mount it.

Also necessary: a sponge, an old, clean towel, paper towels or Kleenex, a large container for water, a spray bottle for water, a sketch book and pencil and eraser, and a large plastic palette.
