

# BEGINNING DRAWING CLASS

Classes meet in the Oaks Center in Sun City

The Oaks is off Dell Webb Blvd, between Whispering Wind and Texas Drive.

Arrive 15 minutes early to claim your space and get set up.

Arrive early each and every time class meets.

Supplies: **All supplies are available at Michaels or Hobby Lobby - in Georgetown,**

Pad of good quality drawing paper 11" x 14", Spiral bound preferred (No news print!!!).

Spiral bound sketch diary 3" x 5" (or 6" x 4") – one that will fit in purse, or pocket

Eraser a White eraser -- The "MOO" brand is especially good. This eraser is white and comes in a set of 2 erasers - you may be able to share the cost of a set with another student..

Kneaded Eraser. (Used to lighten a too dark area of the drawing')

Artist's brush about 1/2" wide, with bristles (real or synthetic) that are about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to  $\frac{3}{4}$ " long  
To "swish" away unwanted vine charcoal marks, and eraser dust

Vine (or Willow) Charcoal. One stick is all you will need - about 1/4 "(more or less) diameter.  
These Vine Charcoal sticks come 3 to a box, and rated 'VERY SOFT, SOFT, or MEDIUM'  
I prefer the soft or medium. But any of them will be OK.

Wolff (brand) Carbon Pencils one set of 4. The set contains 1 each of B, 1B, 4B, 6B.
